

Title of the paper (14pt, centered, not all capitals)

1st Author(12pt, bold, centered)

Department, Name of the Institution, City – pin code, Country (12pt, italics, centered)

2nd Author

Address (Similar to above)

3rd Author

Address (Similar to above)

Abstract(10pt, bold, centered)

(Text in abstract should be 10 pt)

Key words(10pt, bold, centered)

Markov chain, Forecasting.

(Key words should be separated by commas and each key word should start with a capital, no bold, 10pt).

1. Introduction (section heading 12pt, bold, not all capitals, not centered, number 1, 2,...)

(Text should be in 12pt)

- All figures/photographs and tables should be numbered in the order of appearance in the text. They should be in black and white and should be given a descriptive title (10 pt, bold, centered, not all caps) at the top. Place the figures and tables in the document keeping the page breaks, etc. in mind.
- Equations should be centered and numbered in the order of first appearance in the text. Equation no. should be in 10 pt, bold, in parenthesis (**no.**) and placed at the right end of the line.
- When references are used: Author/Authors' name(s)(year). Example: Arneales M. N. (2002)
- Subsections should be numbered as 1.1, 1.2, etc...followed by **subsection heading (12pt, bold, not all capitals, not centered)**

References (same as a section heading)

(References should be numbered, alphabetically arranged (First author's name). Follow the examples given below)

1. 1st Author and 2nd Author, (Year of publication), Title, Name of the Journal, Vol, No., page nos.
2. 1st Author , 2nd Author and 3rd Author, (Year of publication), Name of the Journal, Vol, No., page nos.
3. Author , *Name of the Book (italics)*, Vol, Edition no., edited by Editor A and Editor B, (Publisher, city ,year.), page nos.
4. Author, *Proceedings ofconference (italics)*, edited by Editor A and Editor B, (city, year.), page nos.

Note: The length of a paper should be ideally within 15 pages. Fonts should be Nimbus Roman (Open office) or Times new roman.(MS Word) or equivalent.
